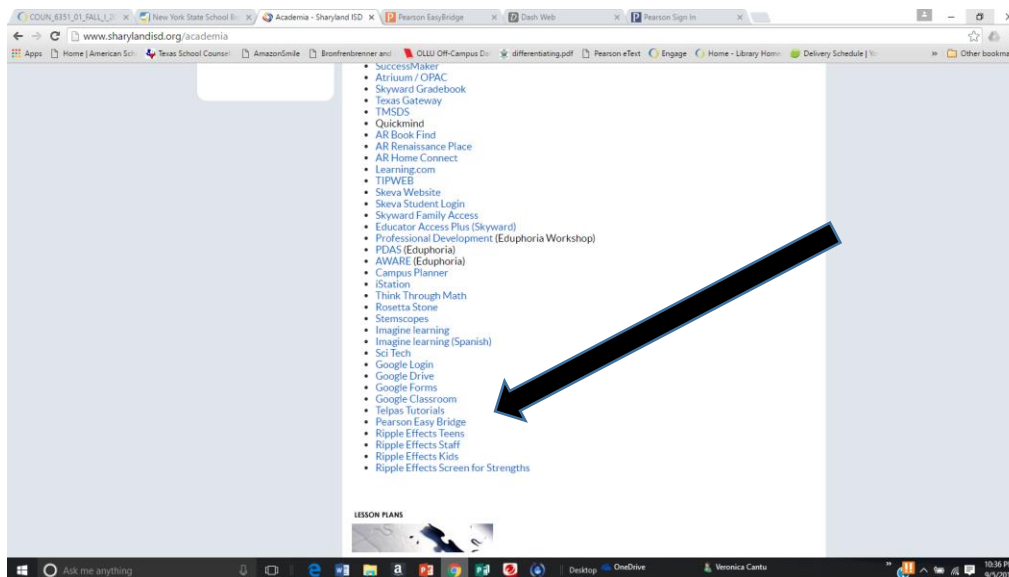
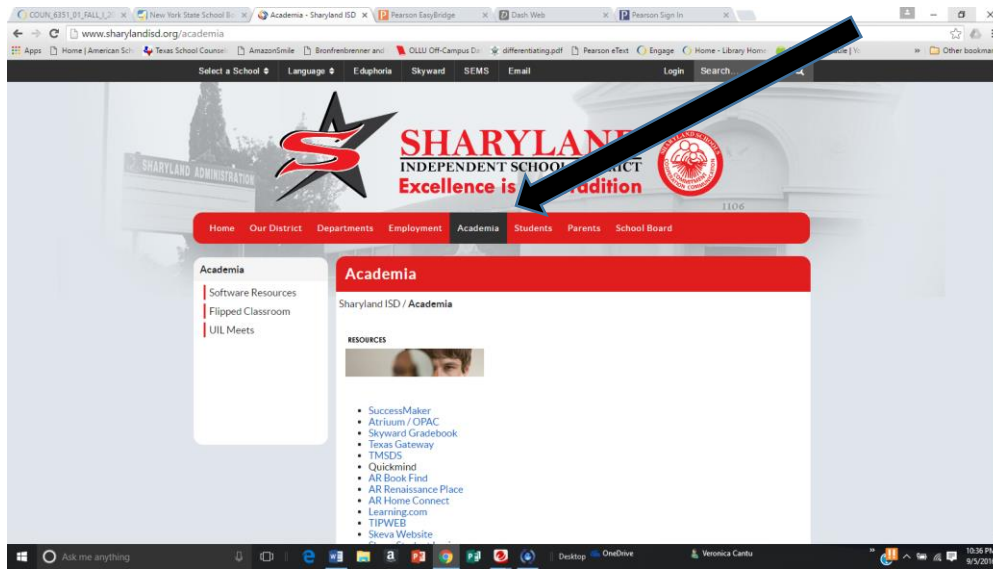


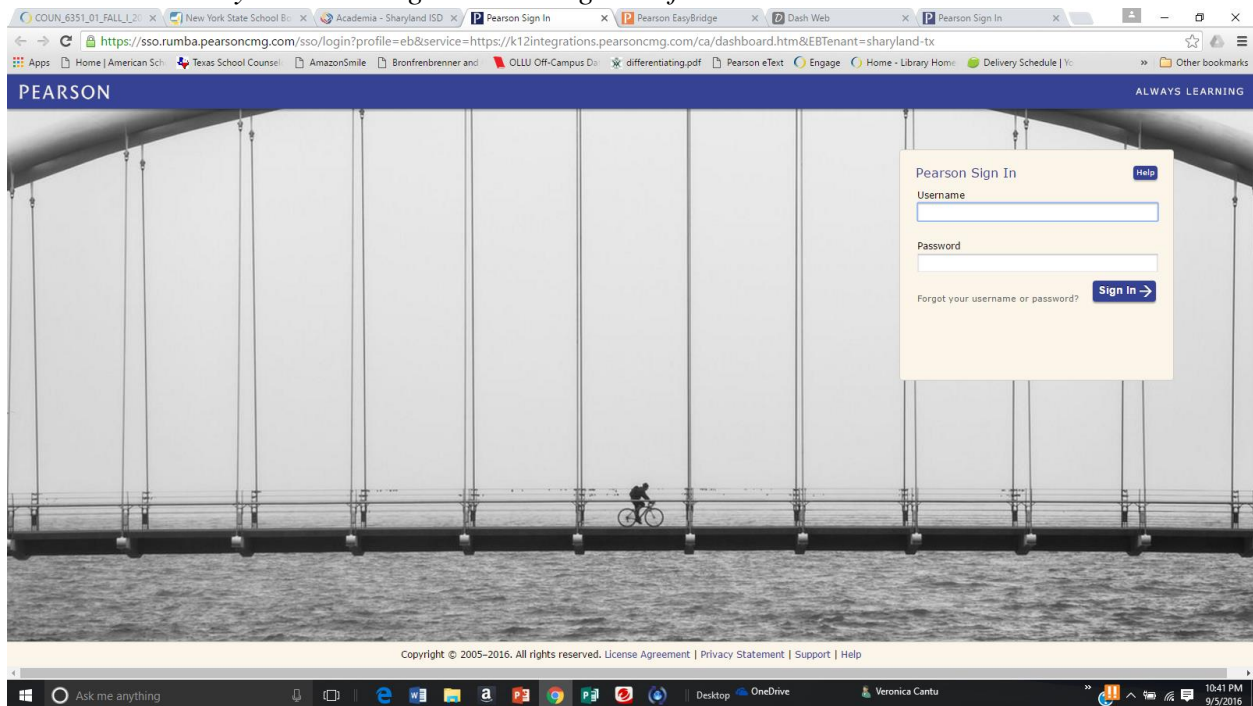
Dear Parents,

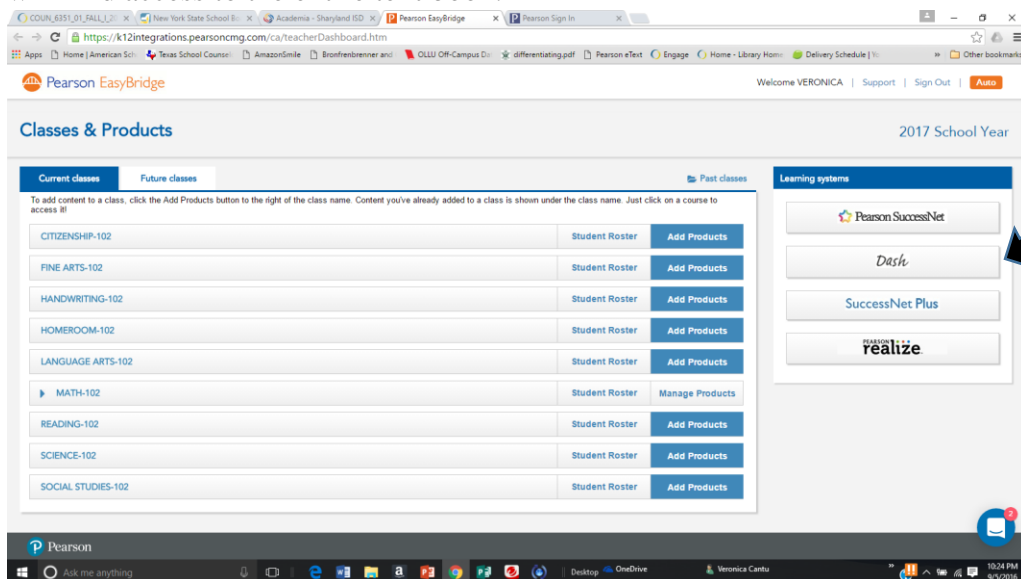
Step 1: go to the Sharyland ISD webpage, click on the Academia tab, scroll down to find Pearson Easy Bridge and click on that link.



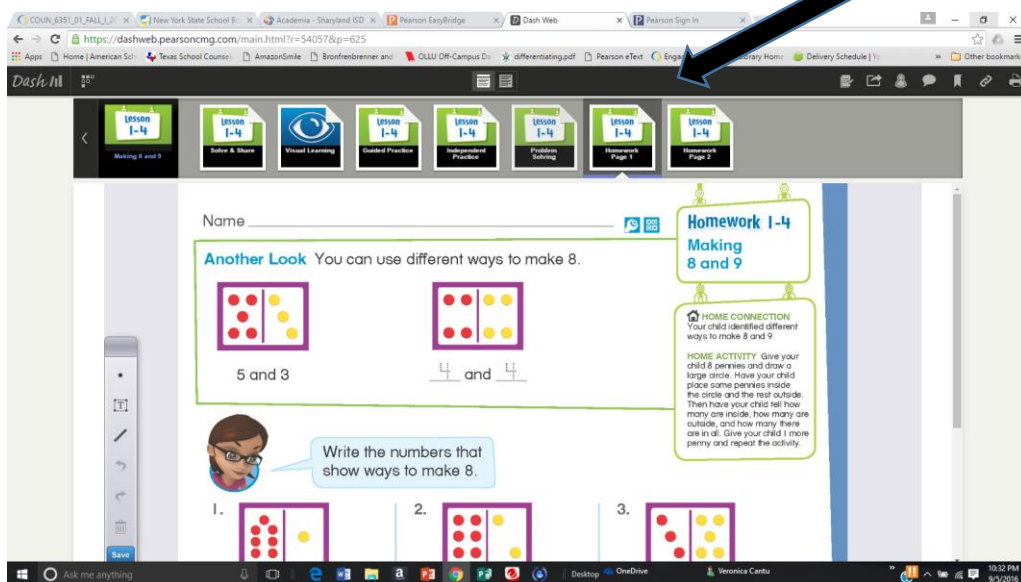
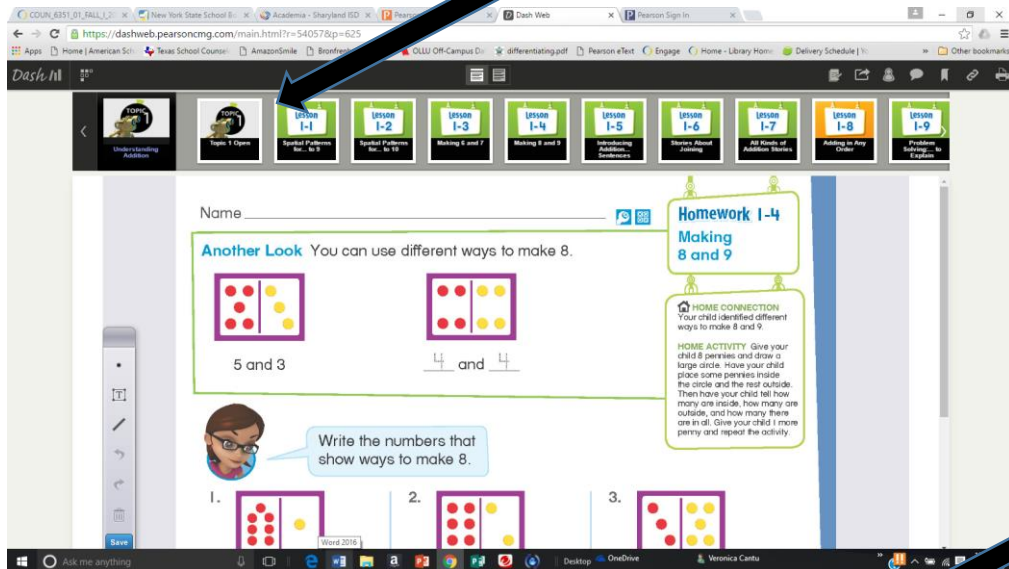
Step 2: Login to your **child's Pearson Easy Bridge Account** using their **AR username and Password**. *This information is inside their B.E.E. binder for your reference only and should not be shared with anyone including other siblings and friends.*



Step 3: Once logged on, click on the DASH tab found on the right side of the screen. There you will find access to the entire text book.

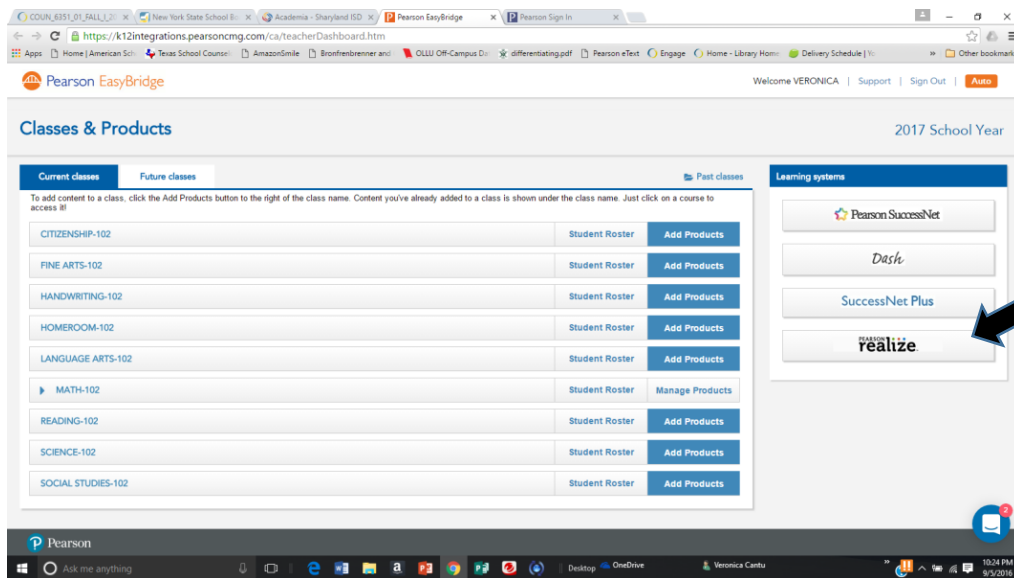

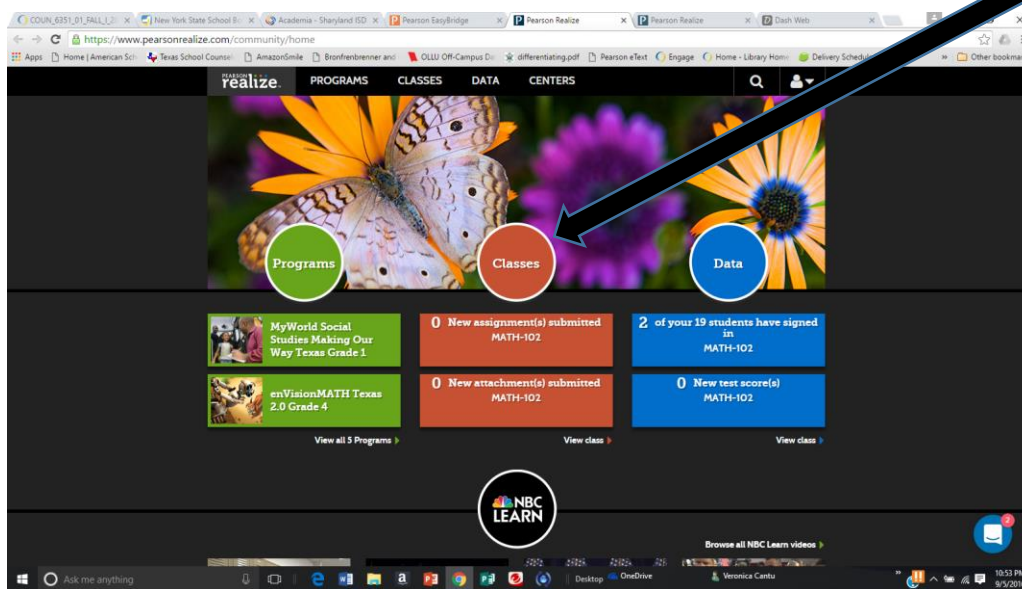


## Online Math Assignments
